

## "Europe 40 Under 40" award

GREEK ARCHITECT PANOS PARTHENIOS AND 60 OF EUROPE'S IMPORTANT EMERGING YOUNG ARCHITECTS AND DESIGNERS NAMED AS "EUROPE 40 UNDER 40" FOR 2009



The European Centre for Architecture Art Design and Urban Studies and The Chicago Athenaeum: Museum of Architecture and Design are pleased to announce the selection of this year's most promising and emerging European design talent for 2009.

A total of 61 architects and industrial designers from architecture and industrial design and manufacturing firms across Europe were selected by a jury of architects that convened in Chicago June 2009.

Geographically, the selected recipients for 2009 "Europe 40 Under 40®" hail from across 19 European nations: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Great Britain, Greece, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, The Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Serbia, Slovenia, Spain, and Switzerland—the best of the young best of Europe.

The "Europe 40 Under 40" program is sponsored by KONE Oyj.

An exhibition of work by the 2009 Laureates opens at Contemporary Space Athens (46-48 Megalou Vassiliou, Rouf-Athens, Greece) on Wednesday, September 16 and continues through November 1. A more formal exhibition and presentation takes place at the symposium, "The City and the World," in Florence, Italy the second week of November 2009.
